
In October, one of our established Eagle Leaders, Jeff Holloway, became the Country Leader for Honduras. And within his first week, held the first JFYM Forum, training eight locals from the church in the village of Mongual to become youth leaders!

3 of those who attended each discipled others, and are meeting weekly to have discussion groups. 4 salvations have resulted, and the group continues growing with all ages - from babies to those in their 80's.

Even in the midst of the pandemic and violence in their nation, our Honduras team persevered with coaching, training, praying, and leadership meetings. Many worshiped, prayed together, and were equipped to reach the younger generation for Christ.

Challenges

- Known as one of the most violent countries in the world
- Level 3 Travel Advisory due to the crimes below and human trafficking, robbery, drug trafficking and rape being very high
- Children violence is extremely high with homicides, disappearances, extortion, sexual abuse, and forced recruitment, causing parents to attempt to migrate to safety but causes many deaths
- Tropical storms damaged 30% of healthcare facilities and 6/15 hospitals
- Thousands of migrants from Haiti, Cuba, and Nicaragua use Honduras as a transit country
- 30% of the population is under age 14
- 50% have access to safe sanitation, 96% to only basic drinking water services

Reach Out

- A gift of \$1,000 helps indigenous leaders train 50 youth pastors through an "in-person" forum in their country.
- A gift of \$500 helps provide scholarships to train and mentor 20 youth pastors online.
- A gift of \$200 (\$3.85 per week) helps us equip 1 leader for 1 year, with the goal of that leader moving from being introduced to JFYM to implementing and multiplying JFYM. As a result, that new leader will begin training 3 additional leaders, so that from those 4 new leaders, there are a total of 12 young people discipled and praying for opportunities to influence 36 of their friends to follow Jesus.
- A monthly gift of \$100 helps us continue current ministry to leaders around the world who are trained and resourced through Reach Out.
